TUB TIME: STRESS SOAK

Ingredients:

 5-10 drops of lavender or sandalwood oil

- 2 Tbsp. carrier oil (such as almond or aloe)
- 2 Tbsp sea salt

Directions:

- 1. Fill tub with warm water
- Add the blended ingredients and make sure salt dissolves
- 3. Soak for 10 to 20 minutes

Remember:

Wait until the tub is filled to add your bath salt. The running water can make the oils evaporate quickly.

KITCHEN SINK TRENDS

Single Bowl: We have been seeing more and more homeowners switching to a large single bowl kitchen sink. In stainless steel, this can be a modern and industrial look for the kitchen. It's great for large pots and pans and since many people mainly use their dishwasher, the need for separate sink bowls has diminished



Low Bowl Divider: Homeowners have chosen this style of sink for many of the same reasons as the single bowl. The low divider allows for larger pots and pans to fit more easily in the sink but still gives the option of keeping water to one side of the sink. The drawback of this style is that it only allows for a shallow amount of water in the sink before filling both bowls.



Front Apron/Farmhouse:

Although not a new product, front apron sinks are a current trend for kitchens. Available in a variety of colors and materials, these sinks can complement any style of kitchen. The stainless steel options are popular for more modern kitchens while white sinks are often chosen for country style kitchens. They come in multiple sizes as well as one or two bowl options to better suit your needs. One drawback is the front of the sink may need to be protected from belt buckles, shirt buttons, etc.
