Whether you are building a new home, remodeling or just redecorating, sites like Pinterest can be a useful tool for planning and inspiration. Here are some of our tips to make the most of your "pins".

Create a lot of different boards – It will help you to stay focused if you split your pins among many boards instead of having just one labeled "New Home" or "Kitchen Remodel". If you are building a new home, try to make a board for each room or if you are remodeling/redecorating, split your boards into categories like "Color Schemes" or "Kitchen Faucets".

Clear out unneeded pins - Once you make a decision, delete any pins not related to that decision (or move them to a different board for future use). This will help keep you focused and will prevent any second guessing of

your choices. For example if you decide you want a contemporary style freestanding tub, remove any pins of more traditional claw-foot style tubs.

Don't take every pin literally – Remember that a lot of the home décor pins on Pinterest come from high-end design magazines or very stylized product catalogs. Although contractors and designers are going to do their best to find what you are looking for, these pins are sometimes best used as inspiration only. Some of the fixtures shown can be hard to find or very expensive, and you need to use what is best for your space and budget.

Don't forget about product pins – Although you may be drawn to pins that show the full look of a room or design, don't skip over the pins of specific products. Many companies will pin products they love and

recommend. For example, Delta pins pictures of all of their faucets with a link to that specific webpage. This is a good way to find reviews and more information to help you narrow down your choices. It also gives you a close up view of an item that may be lost in a larger picture.

Follow boards from local businesses – When you follow local businesses, you can get a sense of what is available in your area and the kind of work they do. **Northern Plains Plumbing** even has a board dedicated only to images of their own work.
