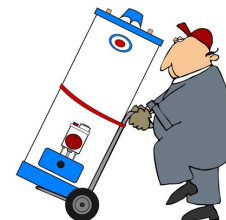

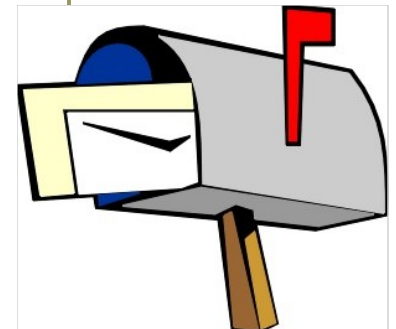


KEEP WIPES OUT OF PIPES

Use Vinegar for Cleaning Tile!

Vinegar is a natural & non-toxic product that safely cleans , deodorizes and disinfects most hard surfaces. White vinegar can break down grease & hard water stains without harsh fumes. You can customize the scent by adding a few drops of essential oil to your vinegar.

Mix 1/4 to 1/2 cup vinegar with 1 gallon of water to use on tile floors & showers and apply with a mop or sponge. It can then be air dried or dried with a towel.

For tough stains, scrub first with baking soda and then rinse with vinegar-water solution. Some of the solution can be kept in a spray bottle for quick cleaning. For your safety, do not mix vinegar with bleach.
