Make sure to inspect these pipes and keep them clear. Another very important reminder is keeping an eye (or nose) out for gas leaks. If your home has either natural or propane gas make sure everything is in good working order and free of damage. If gas is smelled call the Fire Department, MDU or service provider, then Northern Plains to inspect. Do not take gas smells lightly and have inspected right away.
